## **CoEJ Train the Trainer (TTT) Program for Safeguarding Facilitator Level one**

### **Overall Goal**

To build capacity within our community to safeguard children.

### **Aim**

To train 16 participants to undertake level one safeguarding train the trainer.

### **Context**

With the grace of Allah (SWT), CoEJ has previously rolled out Educare and run different programs supporting Safeguarding across the UK and Europe. Safeguarding continues to be one of our top priority area.

All our volunteers and teachers that are part of any program run under CoEJ including madrasah where children are involved need to have completed Safeguarding level one training.

This train the trainer has been organised to build capacity for trainers to conduct local safeguarding sessions at their madaris/ group. After the training, madaris/ groups will be equipped to have a Safeguarding induction which is mandatory before new volunteers join.

### **Objectives**

Participants will be given a Level one externally accredited certification to run level one safeguarding programs

Given knowledge base to be able to run the safeguarding level one training

They will be given Facilitation and presentation skills.

An opportunity to present

### **Person Specification:**

The ideal candidate would:

- Have the ability to give and receive feedback
- Understand the workings of their Madrasah/ group
- Have strong interpersonal skills

**Program Overview:**

This two-day residential workshop will be delivered by an external Trainer with the support of Rizwan Rahemtulla who will make this training relevant to our organisation. There will be an opportunity to present material, receive and give feedback, discuss your Madrasah Safeguarding Policy, share training material and look into real case studies from a Mosque/ Madrasah setting.

**Fee:**

We are requesting individuals (Who can be funded by their madrasah or their activity parent body) to contribute £120 per person which will go towards costs including accommodation, all meals and course materials.

A full refund will be given if your application is unsuccessful. If your application is successful, a refund cannot be possible. However, a replacement may be able to attend.

Successful candidates will be required to:

- Attend the two-day residential Train the Trainer Program
- Attend at least one CPD (Continuous Professional Development) program every year for their personal growth and development
- Facilitate at least two (half-day) Safeguarding training sessions at their Madrasah/ group
- Be part of a 'Safeguarding Trainers' WhatsApp group, where Trainers can be part of a network that supports and learns through each other
- To conduct Safeguarding Inductions before new volunteers, join their group

The content covered over the two days:

- To understand your responsibilities with regard to Safeguarding Children and Young People
- To know how to respond appropriately if you are worried or have concerns that a child is being abused or neglected
